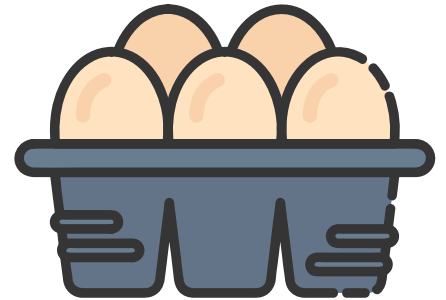


## SURFACE TENSION WITH WATER DROPS

This rubber egg experiment is a classic science activity! Make a naked egg or bouncy egg. Can it bounce? So many questions and one simple experiment using everyday supplies.

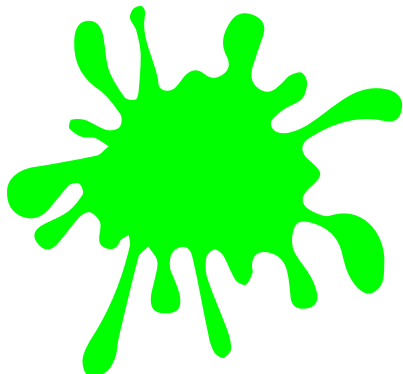
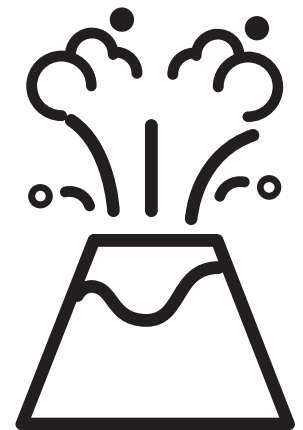


## HOMEMADE LAVA LAMP
