## >DISTRICT GOAL

Implement a comprehensive academic program which assesses readiness and advancement in grades Pre-K through 12, providing the opportunity for student learning to culminate college and career readiness.

## >SCHOOL GOALS

**By the end of 2025, 80% of all students will be performing at grade-level in English/Language Arts:**

\*ELA in Grades 1-2 will be measured by the percentage of students achieving "Benchmark" scores on the End-of-Year DIBELS Assessment.

\*ELA in Grades 3-5 will be measured by the percentage of students achieving scores of "Mastery" or "Advanced" on the LEAP 2025 Assessment.

**By the end of 2019, 80% of all students will be performing at grade-level in Math:**

\*Math in Grades 1-2 will be measured by the percentage of students scoring 75% correct or greater on District Created End-of-Year SLT Mastery Assessments.

\*Math in Grades 3-5 will be measured by the percentage of students achieving scores of "Mastery" or "Advanced" on the LEAP 2025 Assessment.

## >ROLES OF THE SCHOOL & TEACHER

- > Provide ongoing reports about child's academic progress to parents

## >ROLES OF THE PARENT

Abney Elementary parents will collaborate with the school and teachers in order to extend learning opportunities from the classroom into the home environment.

### As parents, your responsibilities will be to:

- > Ensure your child is on time, attends school regularly, is well-fed, and is well-rested on a regular basis
- > Encourage and acknowledge your child's academic and social achievements
- > Talk to your child each day about school (what is being studied, how was his/her day, interesting events....etc.)
- > Review all school communications and respond promptly; (daily communication logs, website, phone calls from teachers or school).
- > Support the school and teachers in maintaining a safe and orderly learning environment
- > Provide effective and appropriate discipline which consists of praise, encouragement, and is consistent and fair
- > Set aside time to read with your child
